



## 2010 Green Bay Holiday Parade Information Update

**The Green Bay Holiday Parade is quickly approaching. The date is set for Saturday, November 19<sup>th</sup>, 2011. The Power of Dance is going to be dancing in the parade this year to music provided by a local radio station.**

### **What the dancers will be doing:**

The instructors have put together a short routine for the participants ages 7 and up to do while walking the route. Dancers under the age of 7 or those who do not wish to learn the routine will be marching with holiday streamers. The music will be playing from a CD by the radio station van.

**How the dancers prepare:** All students taking a class at the POD are invited to participate in the Green Bay Holiday Parade. A very easy short routine will be taught to the kids during the last few minutes of each performance class a few weeks prior to the parade. This routine will then be reviewed often so that all dancers are comfortable. Dancers NOT IN A PERFORMANCE CLASS should make plans with the front desk to learn the parade routine during another class. **All students are asked to attend the last practice/dress rehearsal, Friday, November 18<sup>th</sup>, from 4:15-4:45pm in the POD parking lot. Practice will begin promptly at 4:15pm- please plan on arriving between 4:00-4:15pm. (Friday classes will run ½ hour late on Nov 18<sup>th</sup>) Once we find out the parade line-up, the POD will notify all students what time & where to report downtown on the day of the parade.**

### **What the dancers will wear:**

The directors have chosen a navy blue pullover, hooded sweatshirt with the POD logo on it in white printing. These will need to be ordered through the studio. Students who do not currently have a sweatshirt or have a sweatshirt in poor condition (cut and/or faded) are asked to order one through the front desk. The sweatshirt cost is \$27 + tax (\$28.49) for adult and youth sizes. Payment is due upon registration. The dancers will be required to wear black pants and athletic shoes of their own choice. Keep in mind layers for warmth when ordering your sizes!

### **Sweatshirts should be ordered during costume week!**

If the dancer is in a pom class, the dancer will be performing with poms. Students should bring their own poms. If the dancer is in hip hop or jazz, the dancer will perform without poms.

The Holiday Parade organizers request that ALL participating in the parade dress in holiday attire. In which case, any other festive additions the students would like to make/wear is encouraged. (i.e. minor face painting, red ribbons in their hair, a Santa hat, bells, etc.) Please notify the instructors of any additions your child will be making to his/her outfit.

### **Age notification:**

*If your child is 6 and under, they MUST be accompanied by a parent, or set up someone to be walking with them for supervision.*

We are excited to have this opportunity and would like to showcase the talent we have at the POD! If you are interested in joining us, please fill out the permission slip on the next page (additional permission slips available at the POD front desk. The permission slip needs to be turned in ASAP. Sweatshirts will be ordered Nov 1<sup>st</sup>.
